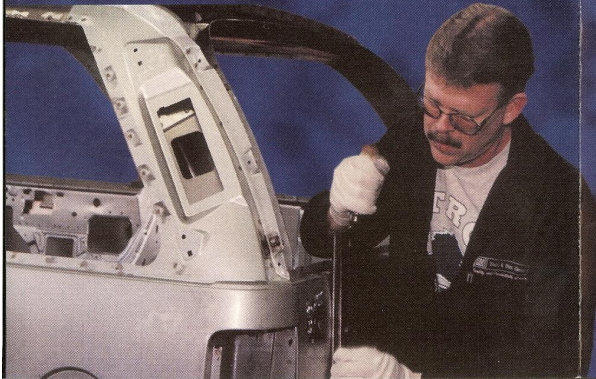

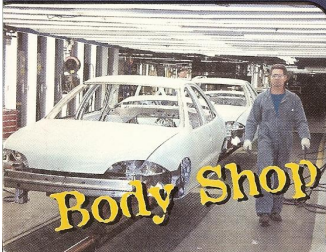

Stamping

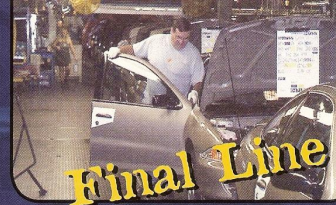


Our team of trainers specializes in strategies to capture the attention and then maintain the interest of each technician throughout the instruction process.

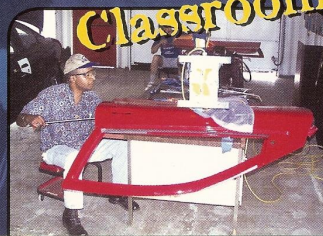

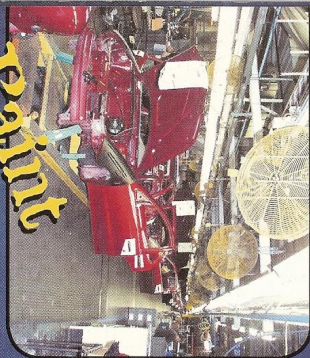

On the moving line, there is very little time to make all repairs needed. Some of the damaged material gets through to Trim, where further damage is possible before going onto the line.

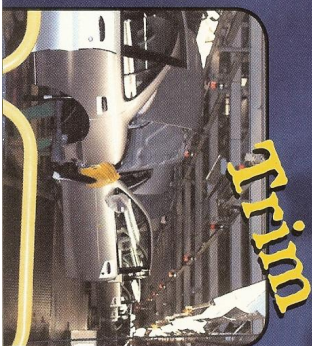
